## Home Assignment Update

Since we left the U.S. in 2014, we have been taking three-year terms on the field between home assignments. We were due for a home assignment starting this summer 2024 and into 2025. However, after much prayer and consideration, we have decided to come back to the U.S. for only a two-month home assignment in July and August this year. This will give our kids some consistency with their studies in school. For the 2022-23 school year, our kids attended a school in Yamoussoukro. For the 2023-24 school year, after our move last year, they've transitioned to a school in Abidjan. While the transition was challenging at first, the kids have settled in and the school here in Abidjan is a good fit for them for this stage of their education. Instead of coming on home assignment and transitioning them to new schools this fall (2024), which would have been their third school in three years, we decided to return to Abidjan at the end of August, at their request, so they can go to their current school for this next year as well. We feel that this stability is important for them. Yet that means that our time in the U.S. will be short, and while we hope to visit several churches during July and August, we will not be able to visit everyone as we'd like to.
