are thankful that the Lord helped us get on the same flights all the way to Abidjan, including baggage. And what an adventure we have been on since landing in Abidjan!



We had only been in country for three weeks when our first guests arrived. The CBH-USA team came to connect with our radio team in CI that produces French broadcasts aired throughout the country, targeting teens and young adults. Our local radio team is made up of a talented group of three speakers and two technicians, who prepare weekly programs, leading panels of young adults and church



adults and church leaders discussing themes of interest to African youth. The USA team,

ers, worked with our local team to install new equipment and discuss production issues. They also met with the Radio Committee to make plans for future radio programming and development. While with us, our guests traveled across the country,

Through the years that we have been in Côte d'Ivoire, the majority

tended the Yamoussoukro Church of God whenever we were not traveling to other congregations. During this time, LeAnn has really sensed a need for the young youth. (Persons who are between 13 years of age to 20. Note that in Côte d'Ivoire, anyone who is over 17 until they are mar-ried are called youth.) This started with a special Sunday school class separate from the young children. During these classes, they felt the freedom to ask questions about the Bible, faith, What is the church ?, Who is the church ?, etc.



This is a place were they can go deeper in their understand ing of who they are in Christ. This group continues to grow both numerically and spiritually.

The older youth have recognized the importance of this group and are inviting them to become part of the youth group. On February 18 the youth committee came to our how encouraging to see almost 60 young and older youth at our home on the veranda!
