#### **Pray for Peace**

The presidential election in Côte d'Ivoire is set for October 31, 2020. There have already been violent protests in Abidjan leading to several deaths. Please pray for peaceful elections and a smooth transition of power.

It was a clear Wednesday morning, June 24, as the drilling rig team arrived on site to begin drilling the well as part of Phase 1 of the Lakpolo Ministry and Activities Center. Pastor Yeo, the local church, and all of us missionaries

(praying from a distance) hoped that the drilling team would hit water at the first location they tried. If the team would have to move locations, it would cost more money for each additional attempt.

Before they began to drill, some local elders from the village told them to offer an animal sacrifice to get the help of the ancestors so they could be successful in finding water. The leader of the drilling team, a Christian, said the well was for Christian work, so they wouldn't do that. The team began drilling, and Pastor Yeo arrived. They drilled 80 meters and hit rock. The believers began to pray. They continued to drill, even though some of the drilling team wanted to move to



a different location. At 100 meters, the well was still dry. Some of the team members were ready to give up, but the lead technician said they'd drill a little deeper. When they hit 105 meters down, water gushed out! The village chief later told Pastor Yeo that at a nearby clinic, they had to drill in three spots before finding water, and even then, the pressure was not as stong. What an incredible testimony to the power of Jesus, who gives living water!
