Bobby describes his experience as "the hardest physical thing" he's done and freezing cold. But it was also surreal, beautiful, and a wonderful team bonding experience!

VBS Camp Encourages Kids and Churches Alike



July brought the opportunity for kids from around the central region of the country to gather for VBS Camp! The three-day camp was packed with games, lessons, worship, and Bible verse activities. Teachers who had been trained by Bobby and Jenny in April taught on the human body, puberty, and menstruation with the boys and girls separated into two different classrooms. The girls received Days for Girls kits (*pictured right*), washable menstruation kits that last for up to three years.



We were thrilled to see a number of Children of Promise kids in attendance at the camp, including Emmanuel (*pictured bottom right*), from the Yamoussoukro church.

Jenny also had the opportunity to teach a couple of English classes during the camp, helping the students learn songs and Bible verses in English



(pictured left). It was a joy to see the VBS teachers come together to pull off this camp which was a wonderful encouragement for the children and the church at large!
