Hand washing at critical moments (ex. before handling food) can reduce illness in children under five by almost 50%!

Children of Promise Partners with Days for Girls



Gathered on wooden benches in the sanctuary of the Plateforme Church of God, Children of Promise sponsored girls (pictured left) and their mothers gathered with other youth girls for a time of teaching on being created in God's image, puberty and menstruation, trafficking, and personal hygiene. A time of Q & A followed the teaching, and then each school-aged girl who attended received a personal hygiene kit with washable pantiliners and pads that last up to four years. Discreetly placed in a drawstring cloth bag, each kit has everything in it that a young lady needs to attend school and be active every day of the month. We are grateful for a team of seamstresses who donated kits and made this necessity accessible to the girls!

While the girls were gathered with their mothers, the boys met with their fathers in a nearby Sunday school room where they learned about God's call for them to be men of honor, caring for their families, changes in their bodies, and personal hygiene, particularly through hand-washing. Running water is not available at the church, so the men and boys built a Tippy Tap handwashing station next to the church's outhouse using wood, cord, rocks, soap, and an empty carton. A wooden lever connects a cord to the carton, allowing water to spill out like a tap for hand washing. Our prayer is that the Lord will use these tools to help each of these children, youth, and adults be healthy and strong so they can serve the Lord for many years to come!
