Created in God's Image

Being assured that we are each created in God's image, that our bodies are the temple of God, is important for both young women and young men. Some girls in sub-Saharan Africa struggle to manage their menstrual cycles due to lack of access to hygiene products. Teaming with a program called Days for Girls, Jenny trained nine female VBS/Sunday School teachers and Bobby trained six male teachers in April who will in turn teach young women and men about how God created their bodies, how to honor God with their bodies, and what it means to go through puberty. Girls who complete the training will receive washable menstruation kits sewn by generous donors that last up to three years. These miles across Africa from West to East symbolize the need that children across Africa — and the world — have for education, nutrition, healthcare, and discipleship. We asked, you answered!


In our last update, we shared that our budget increased due to Rease's school fees.
