As we prepared for our return to Côte d'Ivoire in June, there were some new things we needed to think about: buying "flexible" tickets in case quarantine was unexpectedly necessary, getting our Covid tests scheduled at the just the right time to get the results back not too early but not too late, and getting a "movement" document from the Ivorian government to track our travel. But one detail (which was not new!) that we had overlooked was discovered just 3 1/2 weeks prior to our scheduled June 25 departure: Jenny's passport had expired in April! With passport processing times being much longer than they were pre-Covid, the only way to get a passport in less

than four weeks was to secure a hard-to-get appointment spot on the website (*pictured top left*) and appear in person at the Detroit Passport Agency within three days of the flight for an emergency renewal. The Lord made a way, and on June 22, Jenny

had her passport renewed. Three days later, just as planned, we departed Indianapolis and arrived in Côte d'Ivoire! Our flights were the smoothest they've been in years, with easy layovers, and the kids slept a lot of the way! Who knew that the bumpiest part of the ride was going to be before we ever boarded the plane! We are grateful to God for providing all we needed to get back to life and ministry here in CI.
