IBAO-Update

IBAO exists to aid the Church in preparing servants of the Lord to serve, teach, preach and be the hands and feet of Jesus. As a part of the IBAO program, each student is to do an internship or project in service to a church or the church at large for a total of 13 weeks. Seven students did

their internships under the leadership of a pastor in a local church. Our only female student this year, Sylvie N'Goran (younger sister of the late Pastor Daniel), with a heart for young girls and their relationship with Jesus, carried out a project in response to the needs of young ladies to be dedicated to the Lord in all areas of their lives. She also worked with the women of the church to come along side these young ladies and walk with them during this formative time in their lives. She especially targeted the issues of abstinence and faithfulness, holding five seminars with the girls and women in Yamoussoukro. Sylvie incor-



porated guest women speakers to share their testimonies, teach and encourage the girls. Sylvie maintains a strong tie with the young girls as mentor and confidante. We hope to see this program spread to other churches in the future. Hers is just one of several exciting stories of promising young leadership for the church.
